Bricolage/Craft

Un signet Minion/Minion Bookmark

Materials: yellow paper (15cm x 15 cm), blue paper, black paper, white paper, scissors, glue stick, black and grey pens

Instructions:

1. Make your basic origami bookmark corner in yellow.
 - a. Fold the square paper across the diagonal to make a triangle
 - b. Rotate to bring the long edge parallel, then bring the right corner up to meet the top corner
 - c. Repeat with the corner. You should now have a smaller diamond with a line down the middle
 - d. Open up the last two folds
 - e. Folds down the top corner - only take one sheet of paper
 - f. Bring the right corner back up and fold into the flap
 - g. Repeat with the left corner
2. Once you have made the basic YELLOW bookmark corner, cut out a triangular piece of BLUE paper that perfectly fits into the bottom half of your corner bookmark triangle.
3. Then trim the edges to make a diamond and glue into place. This makes your Minion's trousers.
4. Next cut a black strip of paper - approximately 1cm wide - and glue it across the top of half of your origami bookmark corner. Trim the any bits overlapping the sides of the bookmark.



5. Now cut out two circles – approximately the size of a 10p coin. Outline with a silver pen (or glue on grey cardboard, tin foil. These are your paper Minion's eyes. Glue in place.

6. Finally add details with a black pen – the Minion's happy smile, some Minion hair and the G detail on the Minion's trousers.

Marionette Dory/Dory Puppet



Materials: standard #10 envelope, blue paint, orange paint, white paint, yellow cardstock or construction paper, orange cardstock or construction paper, black construction paper, googly eyes, black maker, scissors, glue

Instructions:

1. Seal your envelope shut. Cut it in half. You will use one half for Dory and one half for Nemo. Paint the front of each envelope half, one with your blue paint and one with orange paint. Set them

aside to dry completely.

2. When your orange paint is dry, paint a white stripe across the top of the envelope. Let it dry.

3. Cut out the fins and tail for Dory out of your yellow cardstock paper and a mouth from your black cardstock paper. Cut out the fins and tail for Nemo out of your orange cardstock paper.

4. When your envelopes are dry, glue the fins, mouth and googly eyes onto your envelopes.

5. Use your black marker to add finishing details to your fish. For Dory, add her cute little freckles around her nose. For Nemo, outline the white stripe at the top of the envelope, all of the fins and add a cute smile.

Cuisine/Cooking

Biscuits de Moana/Moana Cookies

Ingredients: $\frac{3}{4}$ cup butter, $\frac{3}{4}$ cup sugar, 2 egg yolks, $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp salt, 2 cups flour, 2 tsp vanilla extract, $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp electric green gel colour, $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp green gel food colouring

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
2. Use a hand mixer to cream butter and sugar together until light and fluffy.
3. Add egg yolks and beat until combined. Pour in vanilla extract and mix well.
4. Mix in salt and flour and beat until well combined.
5. Add electric green gel color and mix until desired color is achieved.
6. Divide the dough in half and wrap one half in plastic. Refrigerate for 10 minutes.
7. Add green gel color to the remaining dough and mix well.
8. Wrap the remaining dough in plastic and chill for 10 minutes.
9. Roll out the electric green dough to 1/8-inch thick on parchment paper.
10. Separately roll out the dark green dough to 1/8-inch thick on parchment paper.
11. Place the light green dough onto the dark green and trim the cookie dough into an 8 by 10-inch rectangle. Roll the two doughs together to create a log and freeze for 10 minutes.
12. Cut the log into $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch cookies and lay flat onto a baking sheet.
13. Use a lollipop stick to make shallow indentations in each cookie.
14. Bake at for 12 to 15 minutes and cool.



Les pommes caramel/Caramel Apples



Ingredients: 6 medium Granny Smith Apples, 1 lbs caramels, 6 wooden sticks (such as popsicle sticks), assorted toppings (sprinkles, nuts, etc)

Instructions:

1. Wash and dry apples. Insert wood stick into stem end of each apple; set aside.
2. Prepare cookie sheet by covering with wax paper.
3. Unwrap caramels and place in saucepan; cover. Cook over low heat and uncover once caramels begin to melt. Stir constantly with a wooden spoon to reduce air bubbles.
4. Holding stick, dip apples one at a time into hot caramel, turning until well coated. Scrape off extra caramel from bottom of apple with spatula.
5. Dip coated apple into shallow bowl filled with topping and place on wax paper.
6. Store in a cool, dry place for no more than a day or two.

Science/Science

Frozen Ice Magic

Materials: bottled water, ice cubes, small bowl, towel

Instructions:

Place 6-12 water bottles in your freezer. Lay them flat on their sides rather than upright. For some reason, they freeze better this way.

Cool the water for about two to two and a half hours. At the two hour mark, take out one bottle and test it. If you can slam it on the counter and nothing forms, the water isn't cool enough yet. When you get one that hardens, it is ready to go, but you'll have to work quickly!

Turn bowl upside down over a towel (to catch the spills) and place a large ice cube on the bowl.

Carefully pour the water slowly onto the ice cube.

The water will create a column of frozen ice!

In about 20 seconds, the water will get too warm for this trick to work.
