Les animaux/Animals

Activity Guide

Vocabulaire/Vocabulary

Bricolage/Craft

Cochon spirale/Pig Twirler

Materials: 2 paper plates, pink paint or markers, black sharpie, string, googly eyes, scissors, glue, tape

Instructions:

1. Paint two paper plates pink. One will make the body for your pig twirler craft and the other will make the head, feet and curly tail.
2. Cut one of the paper plates into a spiral, starting from the outside and working your way into the middle.
3. Cut the middle out of the second paper plate and put it to one side. It will become the pig's head later.
4. Cut two pig ears from the rim of the second plate.
5. Cut 4 pig feet from the rim of the second plate. Use your Sharpie Pen to colour the bottom of the pig's legs black.
6. Cut a round pig snout out of the rim of the second paper plate and draw on two nostrils.
7. Cut a small section of paper plate rim and fold it into a U shape. Glue the pig's snout onto the U shape.
8. Glue the pig's ears, nose and googly eyes onto the round head. Draw on a smile and ear folds.
9. Cut a thin strip of paper plate rim and wrap it around your pen to make a curly pig tail.
10. Glue the pig's head, feet and tail onto the body.
11. Use tape or glue to attach a piece of ribbon to the back of the head.

Les tortues/Turtles

Materials: egg carton, paint or markers, pom poms, googly eyes, pipe cleaners, scissors, glue

Instructions:

1. Cut out individual sections from the base of the egg carton. This is be the body of your turtle.
2. Paint one egg carton section. Let the paint dry and then added details to the shell with a second color.
3. To assemble the turtle, you'll need a pom pom ball for the head, some googly eyes, and pipe cleaners for the legs and tail.
4. Cut the pipe cleaners into small sections. Fold each leg piece in half and then twisted it together. Glue the twisted end to the inside of the shell.

Cuisine/Cooking

Biscuits d'ours polaire (polar bear cookies)

Ingredients: oreos, mini marshmallows, mini chocolate chips, candy for eyes

Instructions:

1. Carefully twist the cookies apart to separate the top and the bottom. Keep the part of the cookie with the cream.
2. Take a mini marshmallow and slightly press it between your finger and thumb to flatten it just a bit. Place the marshmallow on the center of the bottom part of the cream.
3. Press the pointed end of a mini chocolate chip piece into the top center of the marshmallow for the nose.
4. Place the edible candy eyes on the cream and gently press into place.
5. Cut one mini marshmallow into fourths with kitchen scissors. Use two of the fourths on top of the cream for the ears.

Les biscuits d'empreinte de patte/Dog Print Cookies

Ingredients: 1 box of brownie mix, $\frac{1}{4}$ cup canola oil, $\frac{1}{2}$ flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ mini chocolate chips

Instructions:

1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees.
2. Use a mixer to beat the first 4 ingredients together until you have a smooth dough. Stir in the chocolate chips.
3. Roll dough into 2 inch balls and place on an ungreased cookie sheet.
4. Bake for 8-9 minutes. (Since they are made with brownie mix, you want them to be a little underdone so they don't get too hard and chewy).
5. Remove the cookies from the oven and tap each cookie with a tablespoon to create the base of a paw print. Next, use a 1/2 tsp to tap 3 smaller circles above the first circle to finish your print.
6. Let the cookies cool completely on a wire rack.

Note: If the cookies become too chewy after time has passed, a couple of seconds in the microwave softens them up for eating.

Science/Science

Les animaux arctiques/Arctic Animals

Materials: ice cubes, cold water, large bowl, shortening, two Ziploc bags

Instructions:

1. Put a large bowl of water into the freezer to let it get extra cold, and then add the ice cubes.
2. Put a bare hand into the icy water first, just to get an idea of how cold the water really was.
3. Put one hand inside a Ziploc sandwich bag.
4. Cover the bag in vegetable and then another sandwich bag on covering the shortening, to keep it from falling off in the bowl.
5. Stick your hand into the water and see the difference from the first time with the shortening.

Comment des pingouins restent sec/How Penguins Stay Dry

Materials: penguin template, crayons (black, white, orange, and pink), spray bottle, water, blue food colouring

Instructions:

1. Print the penguin template on paper or card stock.
2. Fill a spray bottle with water. You may want to add two or three drops of blue food coloring to the water so that it is visible sprayed on the penguin.
3. Colour the penguin with the crayons. For the experiment to work correctly, the penguin needs to be coloured completely and use a thick coating.
4. Spray the water onto the colored penguin.

Jeux/Games

Deviner l'animal/Guess the Animal

Equipment: Guess the Animal cards

Instructions:

Two players play at one time with their backs to each other. Each player picks an animal card. They can ask 5 'yes or no' questions to the other player to try and figure out what animal card the other player has. After the 5 questions have been asked, each player must guess that card of the other player.

Charades d'animaux/Animal Charades

Equipment: Animal Movement cards

Instructions:

Each person picks a card and acts out the action for that animal so that the other players can guess the animal.

Énigmes d'animaux/Animal Riddles

Equipment: Animal Riddles

Instructions:

One person reads the riddle and the other players have to guess what animal it is.

Trompe d'éléphant/Elephant Trunk

Equipment: empty pop cans, empty water bottles, pantyhose, ball

Instructions:

1. Place a row of empty water bottle alternating with empty pop cans. The goal is to knock down the pop cans without knocking over the water bottles. If you knock down a bottle, you must start again.
2. Place a ball into the foot of one leg of the pantyhose.
3. Before the timer starts, put the pantyhose over your head, with the empty leg tucked into your shirt and the leg containing the baseball swinging in front of you. The baseball should be resting on a table or other platform. Stand with one foot on either side of the center line.
4. Start the timer. Begin swinging the baseball back and forth using your body while moving up the line. The object is to swing the ball far enough to knock over all of the water bottles. If you accomplish this before the 1-minute timer is finished, you've succeeded.

Marshmallowroo

Materials: large marshmallows, plastic bag

Instruction:

In teams of two one person hold the plastic bag against their stomach to create the pouch of a kangaroo. The second person tosses the marshmallow so that their partner can catch them in their pouch (plastic bag). The team that catches the most marshmallows wins.

Exercice/Exercise

Equipment: animal action cards

Instructions:

Pick a card and do the animal exercise that is listed.

- Marcher comme un pingouin/March like a penguin
- Sauter comme un kangourou/Jump like a kangaroo
- Glisser comme un serpent/Slither like a snake
- Piétiner comment un éléphant/Stomp like an elephant
- Courir comme un guépard/Run like a cheetah
- Ramper comme un ours/Crawl like a bear
- Marcher comme un crabe/Walk like a crab
- Sauter comme une grenouille/Jump like a frog
