L'indice/Clue

Activity Guide

### Vocabulaire/Vocabulary

## Bricolage/Craft

### Un décodeur/A decoder

*Materials:* paper fastener, template, scissors

*Instructions:*

1. Cut out the circles on the template.
2. For the middle circle, you can use the one that already has the letters on it or you can create your own code and put the symbols or letters that you want.
3. Align the three circles and attach them together using the paper fastener.

### Un enveloppe/An envelope

*Materials:* construction paper, scissors, glue

*Instruction:*

1. Get any color of construction paper (any paper will do). Make the paper into a square by forming a triangle and cutting off the excess.
2. Place your paper pretty side down, white side up on your folding surface. Fold your paper in half on the diagonal, so it makes a triangle.
3. Unfold the triangle fold and lay the paper flat, pretty side down, white side up, so you can see the diagonal crease you just made.
4. Grab the point at the bottom of the paper and fold it up into a small triangle with the top of the triangle just barely touching the diagonal fold line, crease well.
5. Grab the bottom half of the paper where you just made your triangle and fold the entire bottom half up onto the top half, using the original crease as a hinge. Recreate the crease.
6. Grab the point on the LEFT side of the triangle, fold it inward to about the halfway point. This part takes a bit of guesswork, when you fold the other side, you may need to go back and adjust where this side folds, so crease it lightly.

7. Repeat! Fold the right side over the same way so it overlaps. You want the tip of the right corner to reach all the way to the corner of the envelope on the left, this is important for the next step.
8. Grab the tip of the right side, which should be rest on the bottom left of the envelope. Fold it back on itself to make a mini triangle, with the tip now resting on the bottom right side of the envelope. Crease it well.
9. Grab the bottom of the little triangle and bring it to stand straight up, so it's in the center of the envelope and point directly up (3D). Stick your index finger in between the two layers in the center of the mini triangle that's sticking up, place your thumb on the center crease right in front of you, so you're grabbing the center of the triangle crease on both sides. Using your index finger to direct, use your thumb to push down and create a diamond in the bottom center of the envelope. Crease the bottom edges of the diamond.
10. Glue If Filling With 3D Goodies... If you intend to put 3D surprises such as candies in your envelopes, put a little bit of glue under the left side flap of the diamond. Put under a book to dry.
11. Fold Down the Envelope Flap...Fold the top part of the envelope down so it overlaps your diamond.
12. Tuck in the Top! Tuck the top point of your envelope into the mini diamond.

## Cuisine/Cooking

### Le jus mystère/Mystery Juice

*Ingredients:* 1 galloon Lemon Berry Squeeze Hawaiian Punch, 2 liters Sprite, 18 oz Pineapple Juice

*Instructions:*

1. Pour all ingredients into a large punch bowl.
2. Stir well and serve immediately.

### Les biscuits de loupe/Magnifying Glass Cookies

*Ingredients:* 2 - 2¼ cups all-purpose flour, ½ tsp salt, ¼ tsp baking powder, ½ cup slightly softened butter, ¾ cup sugar, 1 egg, ¾ tsp vanilla extract, ½ tsp almond or peppermint extract, pretzels, chocolate

*Instructions:*

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
2. Mix the flour, salt, and baking powder together in a bowl. Set aside.
3. Cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy.
4. Stir in eggs, vanilla, and almond or peppermint extract.
5. Add dry ingredients and stir just until it's mixed in.
6. Roll out dough to 1/4 of an inch thickness.
7. Cut one large 2 1/2 inch circle then place the smaller, 1 3/4 inch round cutter in the center of the cookie and cut the smaller circle out of the larger circle. Remove the center piece. Set on a parchment paper lined baking sheet.
8. Freeze cookies for 30 minutes until firm.
9. Bake 8 minutes until set.
10. Allow all cookies to cool completely.
11. Dip a pretzel dipping stick into chocolate, remove and allow excess to drip off.
12. Attach one pretzel handle to each cookie using chocolate.

## Science/Science

### Trouver les empreintes

*Materials:* chalk and scissors or cocoa powder and small bowl, tape, a dry paint brush

*Instructions:*

1. Use a pair of scissors to scrape a piece of chalk over a container to collect the powder or just grab some cocoa powder.

2. Find or make a fingerprint. We had plenty to choose from: fingerprints on the door, the windows, the television screen. We decided to use fingerprints from a glass vase.
3. Dip the brush into the powder and carefully dust it onto the fingerprint. The dust will stick to the grease from your finger.
4. Blow off any excess powder and lay a piece of clear tape on the fingerprint. Press the tape flat, then carefully peel it off. Congratulations, Detective! You've lifted the fingerprint!
5. You may want to stick the fingerprint to a piece of colored paper so it's easier to see.

### L'extraction d'ADN/DNA Extraction

*Materials:* 2 tsbp water, ¼ tsp dish soap, pinch of salt, 1 cup rubbing alcohol, strawberry, Ziploc bag, paper towel, skewer or toothpick, rubber band, glass cup

*Instructions:*

1. Prior to starting, place rubbing alcohol in the freezer for 30 minutes.
2. Put a strawberry in a Ziploc bag and mash it.
3. Mix together the 2 tbsps of water, ¼ tsp of dish soap, and the pinch of salt.
4. Add the water and soap mixture to the bag with the mashed strawberry. Squish the bag to mix the solution with the strawberry.
5. Use a rubberband to secure a paper towel to the top of the glass. Push down in the middle of the paper towel gently to create a well to hold the strawberry mixture.
6. Pour the strawberry mixture onto the paper towel. Now, wait patiently to collect some droplets of the mixture. We waited about 3 minutes.
7. After a few minutes, take off the paper towel and strawberry mixture. You should have some drops in your glass. It's okay to have only a few drops. There will still be DNA.

8. Remove the rubbing alcohol from the freezer and add it to your solution. You don't need to add a lot, but I added about a cup.

9. Observe if any DNA starts moving into the alcohol on its own. Take a skewer or other pointy tool like a toothpick or pencil and pick up your DNA!

### L'amure, la munition et tirer/Load, Shoot, Block

#### *Instructions:*

This is played between two players with the following three actions

Load: thumbs point over shoulders

Shoot: both hands shoot

Block: arms crossed in front of chest

The object of the game is to load, then fire (without being blocked) before your opponent does. You must load before you can shoot. If you block a shot, then your opponent must reload before they can shoot again. Once you are loaded you can choose to shoot at any time. However, if you are blocked you must again reload before you can shoot. If you are able to load and shoot successfully, you get one point.
