



CPF-SK Volunteer of the Year Award

Nomination deadline: November 15th

The CPF-SK Volunteer of the Year Award is presented in recognition of the contribution of a volunteer who:

- Is a CPF member
- Demonstrates initiative and dedication
- Gives volunteer service to CPF above and beyond the call of duty in the current calendar year

Procedure:

- Each chapter executive may nominate one person per year
- Nominations must be received by CPF-SK on or before November 15th for the current years' award
- Provincial winner will be selected from the chapter nominees by the CPF-SK Board of directors
- Winner will receive recognition at the CPF-SK AGM/Chapter Planning Meeting
- Form must be completed and signed by two chapter members other than the nominee
- The Volunteer of the Year will be recognized locally in conjunction with the International Day of Volunteers on December 5. Each nominee will receive a certificate and gift from CPF-SK for a local ceremony.
